Eligibility of beneficiary institutions	Academia, SME and Health care organizations
Eligibility of costs, types and their caps	 Calls are open for public and private companies of all sizes as well as for universities and research institutes in Sweden fulfilling the following conditions: Only legal persons are eligible to participate. Natural persons are not allowed. A participating company is registered in Sweden, as a joint-stock (aktiebolag), with business along with a recognizable record of R&D and industrial/commercial activities in Sweden. A participating company has a stable financial status and is able to cover its own expenses for the duration of the project. A participating company is required to provide a credible proof for the positive impacts of the project outcome on the participant's growth and future assets. A participating academic organization (from university or public research institute) will be considered only if there is at least one eligible Swedish company or at least one Swedish end-user (public or private) participating in the same project consortium.
