<b>Eligibility of beneficiary institutions</b>	Mainly universities and research institutes, but business enterprises and other registered communities are principally eligible, too.
<b>Eligibility of costs, types and their caps</b>	Academy funding can be used to cover both direct and indirect research costs of the research team arising from, for example, the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- working hours (salary)</li> <li>- research</li> <li>- travel</li> <li>- national and international collaboration and mobility</li> <li>- work and researcher training abroad</li> <li>- preparation of international projects</li> <li>- publishing (e.g. open access publishing using the golden route).</li> </ul> <p>In this call, the Academy will fund approximately 3-5 projects.</p>
<b>Additional eligibility criteria</b>	The applicant for Academy of Finland research funding (i.e. the principal investigator or PI of a research project) must have the qualifications of a professor or a docent, or be a researcher with a doctoral degree.
