<b>Eligibility of beneficiary institutions</b>	Eligibility criteria for all CIHR research funding programs apply. The business office of the institution of an eligible Nominated Principal Applicant generally administers CIHR funds. <b>Eligibility of costs, types and their caps</b>	Recipients should review the <a href="#">Use of Grant Funds</a> section of the Tri-Agency (CIHR, NSERC and SSHRC) Financial Administration Guide for a complete listing and description of allowable costs and activities.
